Anthony James Pollock is the Vice President International at Monash University with responsibility for international policy development, strategic planning and the development of global partnerships. He is also Managing Director of the University's wholly owned international services company, Monash International Pty Ltd, which focuses on international student recruitment, mobility and support, university access programs such as Monash College and English language programs, and internationally focussed development assistance projects and consultancies.

Before joining Monash in 1992 as Director of the International Office, Mr Pollock was the foundation Director of the International Office at The University of Melbourne. He also served for a period as Adviser to the Vice-Chancellor at the University of the South Pacific. He has held various management positions within higher education over a twenty-five year period. He is a graduate of Monash University.

Mr Pollock's current professional interests include the international dimensions of higher education with a special interest in the development of international education policy within the institutional as well as the national setting. He is active nationally and internationally in international education organisations and has consulted on internationalisation policies and processes in higher education within Australia and abroad.
